Thank you very much for agreeing to serve on the core team for the first Asia team retreat October 13-17, 2014 in Indonesia. Collectively, you are a representative group from the Asia team and with your participation we will be able to develop a more meaningful staff retreat that will set the tone for a vibrant regional team going forward. As a CORE Team Member, please plan to arrive in Jakarta a day earlier--by the evening of Saturday October 11, 2014--in order to attend the core team meeting on Sunday. The Lido Lakes Resort is about an hour and a half outside Jakarta and we will organize transport to and from the resort once we have your flight details.
